Philippians 2:3-4 (ESV)

³ Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility <u>count others more significant than</u> <u>yourselves. ⁴ Let each of you look not only to his own</u> <u>interests, but also to the interests of others.</u>

John 15:1-10 – We must abide in Jesus.

John 15:10 (ESV) - ¹⁰ If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.

John 15:10-11 (ESV) - ¹⁰ If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

Philippians 2:5-8 (ESV)

⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
