What Did Jesus Say About Loving Us?

John 15:9-13 NIT

⁹ "I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. ¹⁰ When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love. ¹¹ I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!

¹² This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. ¹³ There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends.

1. God's Love – Inner Strength & Stability

Ephesians 3:16-17 _{NLT}

¹⁶ I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit.

¹⁷ Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.



2. God's Love – Power to Understand New Dynamics

Ephesians 3:18 _{NLT}

¹⁸ And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is.

Our Challenge: Love should motivate everything

1 Cor. 13:2-3 _{NLT} ²...if I had such faith that I could move mountains, but didn't love others, I would be nothing. ³ If I gave everything I have to the poor and even sacrificed my body, I could boast about it; but if I didn't love others, I would have gained nothing.



3. God's Love – Experience Fullness with Power

Ephesians 3:19-20 _{NLT}

¹⁹ May <u>you experience</u> the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God. ²⁰ Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think.



How Does God's Love Impact Us...?

We experience God personally We discover ourselves We abandon damaging decisions

We restore what's valuable We see others from God's perspective We change our priorities

We experience God's presence and power
We flourish individually and together

Ephesians 5:1-3 _{NLT}

¹ Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. ² Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us...
